Day 1 Sun. Bergen

Arrive Bergen. You will be met and transferred to your hotel. Meet your tour escort and fellow travellers this evening at a welcome meeting. Why not arrive a day earlier to give yourself more time to explore Bergen at leisure and take the not-to-be missed funicular railway known as Fløibanen, to the top of the nearby mountains for some stunning views. Overnight Bergen.

Day 2 Mon. Bergen to Hardangerfjord & Norheimsund

Morning sightseeing tour of Bergen, including the popular fish market and historical Bryggen. Depart for Norheimsund via the beautiful Hardangerfjord. Overnight Norheimsund. **BD**

Day 3 Tue. Norheimsund to Flåm & Balestrand

After breakfast, continue your journey via Voss to Stalheimen, located at the very top of the Nærøydalen Canyon with a panoramic view of the valley. Drive via the panoramic route to the idyllic village of Flåm from where you take a fjord cruise to Gudvangen. Continue by coach to Vangsnes, crossing the Sognefjord, the longest and deepest fjord in Norway,

arriving Balestrand for hotel check-in and dinner. Overnight Balestrand. **BD**

Day 4 Wed. Balestrand & Jostedal Glacier

Travel by ferry across the Fjærland before reaching Jostedal and the Breheimsenteret Glacier Centre located near the Jostedal Glacier. The Jostedal Glacier is the largest glacier on the European mainland. The glacier and some of the nearby valleys are protected as a national park. In front of the glacier is a small lake which can be crossed by passenger ferry. Lunch and entrance fee are included at the Breheimsenteret Glacier Centre. Overnight Balestrand. **BLD**

Day 5 Thu. Balestrand to Flåm & Oslo

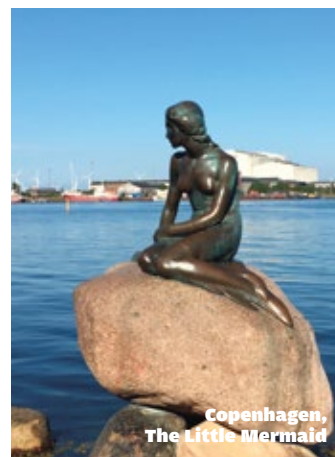
Mid-morning departure across the Sognefjord to Flåm, before taking one of the most beautiful rail journeys in the world - the Flåm Railway. This spectacular rail journey offers a panoramic view of some of the wildest and most magnificent scenery in the Norwegian fjord landscape. The Flåm Railway is one of the steepest train lines in the world on normal tracks, where almost 80 percent of the journey has a gradient of 5.5 degrees. Upon arrival at the mountain station of Myrdal, you change trains and travel on the Bergen line to the Norwegian capital, Oslo. Overnight Oslo. **B**

Day 6 Fri. Oslo

This morning you have a city tour of Oslo. Highlights include the Vigeland Park with its 200 sculptures and a visit to Holmenkollen ski jump for panoramic city views. Your afternoon is free to explore the Old Town or take one of the local ferries to Bygdøy peninsula and visit one of the many museums. Overnight Oslo. **B**

Day 7 Sat. Oslo to Stockholm

Travel by coach or train through the picturesque countryside of Norway

Day 8 Sun. Stockholm

After breakfast, begin your city tour of Stockholm, spanning 14 islands. You will see the old city centre of Gamla Stan, the 700-year-old cathedral of Stockholm, Storget Square and Fjällgatan with panoramic views of the city. Your afternoon is at leisure. Overnight Stockholm. **B**

Day 9 Mon. Stockholm to Copenhagen

Morning departure by coach or train for Copenhagen. Travel south through the Swedish countryside via the coastal city of Malmö. Malmö and Copenhagen are connected by one of the longest bridges in the world - the Øresund Bridge. Upon arrival in Copenhagen, the rest of your day is free. Overnight Copenhagen. **B**

Day 10 Tue. Copenhagen

Morning city tour of Copenhagen. Highlights include the old waterfront district at Nyhavn, the Royal Palace at Amalienborg and not forgetting the Little Mermaid statue. You may wish to explore the iconic Tivoli Gardens during your free afternoon (entrance not included). Overnight Copenhagen. **B**

Day 11 Wed. Copenhagen

Tour services end today with your transfer to the airport. **B**
