### Day 1 Warsaw

Arrive Warsaw, where you will be transferred by car to your hotel. Overnight Warsaw.

### Day 2 Warsaw

This morning, you join a panoramic coach tour covering the major landmarks. Highlights include the Old Town and Royal Castle, the Royal Route and the former Jewish Ghetto. Overnight Warsaw. **B**

### Day 3 Warsaw to Krakow

After breakfast, transfer to the train station for your 4-hour journey to Krakow. Arrive Krakow mid-afternoon and transfer to your hotel. Overnight Krakow. **B**

### Day 4 Krakow

After breakfast, join a walking tour of this medieval city. You'll see the Old Town, Renaissance Cloth Hall and a short walk up Wawel Hill takes you to the Royal Castle and the 14th century cathedral. Overnight Krakow. **B**

### Day 5 Krakow

Today choose from either a tour to Auschwitz-Birkenau Concentration Camp or the famous Wieliczka Salt Mine. Tonight you dine at a

traditional restaurant in Krakow's Old Town. Overnight Krakow. **BD**

### Day 6 Krakow

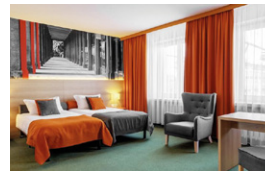
Tour services end after breakfast with your departure transfer. **B**

3 Radziwillowska

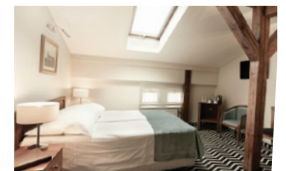
